

Sidney Shriners/Richland Shrine

The Richland Shrine Masons are working hard out in Sidney, MT to raise much-needed funding for the Shriners Hospital for Children in Spokane, WA.

The Sixth Annual Shrine Mason Early Bird Charity Golf Scramble is set for Saturday, May 27th at the Sidney Country Club, an event that has already raised more than \$50,000 for the Spokane hospital. Richland Shriners Jon Skinner and Lance Averett have spearheaded the local effort since its inception. "The golf course was looking for a new group to take the lead on the Early Bird tournament after the previous group dropped out. The Richland Shrine Masons had been looking for a fundraising opportunity and we decided to take this on as an annual event," Skinner said. Last year's event drew more than 100 golfers to the 18-hole course. The tournament is a 4-person Team Scramble with lunch and dinner provided. In addition to the golfers, dozens of area businesses participate financially through a variety of Sponsorship opportunities. Which includes the following: Helping Hand, \$100; Healer, \$250; Angel, \$500; Savior, \$750; and Miracle Worker, \$1,250.

Since 1922, the mission of the Shriners Hospitals has been to provide the highest quality free medical care to children in the fields of pediatrics, orthopedics, burns, spinal cord injuries, and cleft lip and palate. The mission of Shrine Clubs across the globe is to provide the more than \$575 million dollars that is needed every year to keep the Shriners' 22 hospitals in North America up and running. "Children up to the age of 18 are eligible to receive free medical and services in a family-oriented environment at no charge," Averett said. "Many of those children are from right here in Richland County and eastern Montana. These funds help local kids get the care they need."


