



Who is your Potentate?

He received the York Rite Degrees in Chapter Royal Arch Masons, Council Cryptic Masons, and Commandery Knights Templar and has served from the East in each of those bodies in Billings.

He was first appointed to the Grand Lodge Line, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons of Montana, in 2010 and has served through multiple chairs, serving as Grand Master for the 2021 – 2022 year term. He is a car enthusiast starting with a DeLorean and now has several custom Fieros.

Bill married his wife, Patty, in 1983 with two boys and has 2 grandsons. He resides in Billings Montana and has been a business owner for over 30 years where he currently operates a computer system design, consulting, and computer service, company.
